Dear Dudley Ramblers

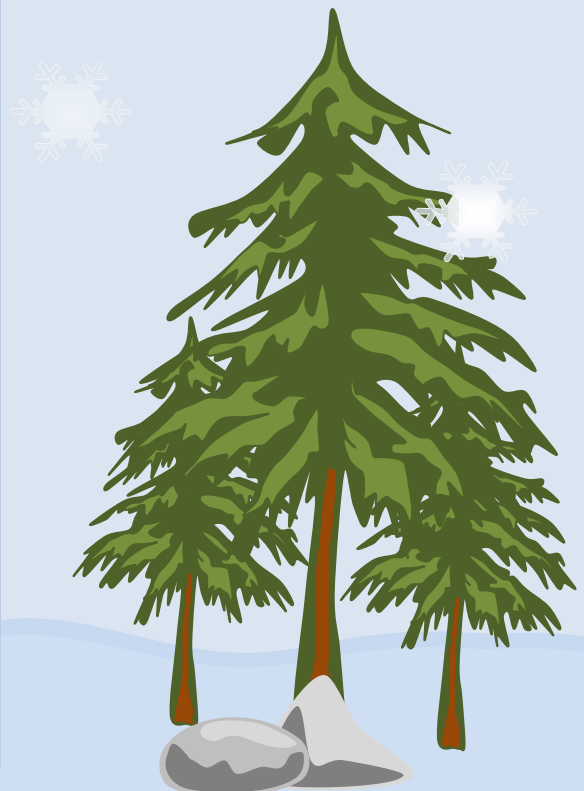
Hello to all and I hope you are all in good health and that life is treating you well.
